## **YEAR 2 TRIP TO THE MUSEUM OF LONDON**

Year 2 will be consolidating their learning about The Great Fire of London with a trip to The Museum of London on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> November.

- Children will need to wear their school uniform, sensible shoes for walking and bring a coat/raincoat.
- We can provide a free school packed lunch for your child to take with them - this will include a drink, cake, pot of finger vegetables, a piece of fruit and a sandwich (please tick one of the sandwich options) or you can choose to send your child in with their own packed lunch from home: a packed lunch and a drink in a disposable carrier bag, labelled with their name, (no nuts, fizzy drinks or sweets please). Please indicate your preference on the slip below.

## **YEAR 4 TRIP TO BRITISH MUSEUM**

On Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November Year 4 will be going to The British Museum to consolidate their learning about ancient Greek temples.

- ❖ We will be travelling from Edgware Station to Tottenham Court Road. Please hand your child over to me in the foyer of Edgware station by 9.20am. I will be at the station from 9am. We will return to Edgware station for 3pm. Please ensure your child has signed out with me before you take them.
