FREE SCHOOL MEALS

We periodically check to ensure that parents of children that are entitled to Free School Meals fill in the relevant forms. Therefore, if you think you may be eligible for Free School Meals or receive Child Tax Credit **and** your annual income is equal to or less than £16,190 **and** you do **not** receive Working Tax Credit, could you please come into the School Office and fill in a form. If you already completed a form last September you do not need to complete another. This also applies to children in Reception Class, Year 1 and Year 2, but will **not** affect their right to receive Universal Free School Meals (until they enter Year 3) which is a different entitlement.
