Other information

Courtland School is a LA school located in the London Borough of Barnet. As a one form entry school it has 210 pupils from the age of 4-11, 13 teachers, 10 Teaching Assistants and 10 non teaching/administration staff. Currently there are no SEN children in the school with a transport element to their statement, The school is situated in NW7 and draws pupils from several postcodes in the North West of the borough. Courtland School is set in a residential area, in Courtland Avenue. Courtland Avenue is a quiet road which leads to the A1. The school site is split either side of the road, with the field being opposite the front entrance to the school. Courtland Avenue also has two large detached houses to the left of the school grounds. It is a quiet road during the day, but at the beginning and end of the school day it is extremely busy as the traffic from Mill Hill County High School uses it as a thorough fare. The school backs on to Mill Hill Golf Club and there is a gate for emergency services access. The school has a main entrance, comprising of a driveway into the school car park, with spaces for 17 vehicles, one of which is for disabled parking, and a pedestrian entrance at the side, both of which lead out onto Courtland Avenue. There is a back entrance to the school that is accessed via Hankins lane, which leads to our playground. The parents bring their children into school via this entrance at the beginning of the day and also collect them from here at the end of the day. There is a new parents shelter and bicycle shelter for bicycles. The infant children are collected from here at 3.15pm and the juniors at 3.25pm.

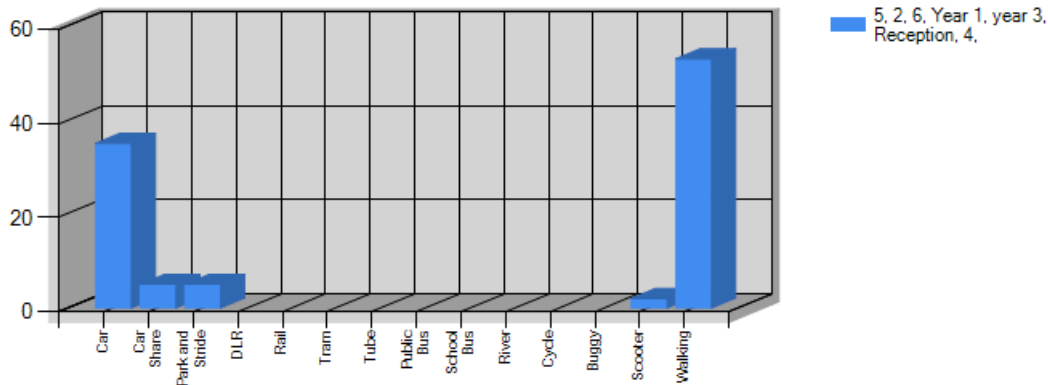

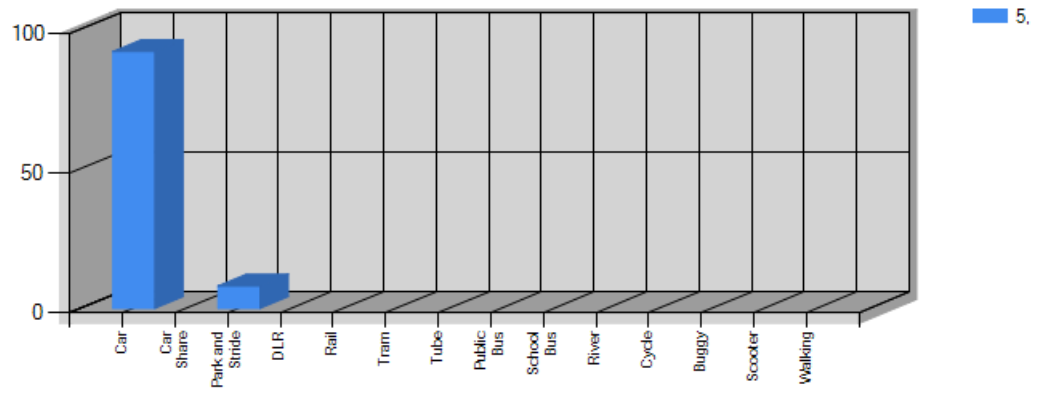

In October 2015 we attended the Travel Plan Top School Awards ceremony and were awarded a School of Excellence trophy for promoting the use of Sustainable Travel. - We have also been involved with the Air Quality Project led by our Borough Advisor Alex Jones. Once again it has been our older children who have taken part. There were three sessions held at school where the children tested the air quality in our school playground compared to our staff car park which is near the A1. As we expected, the results came back with the air quality being better in the playground, although both sets of results were below the Defra limits.
