### **SCHOOL MEALS**

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to free school meals under the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme. Children in Years 3 to 6 need to pay for their school meals; the cost is £2.15 per day.

- **The cost of the lunches for the first half of the Summer Term is £62.35** (from 17<sup>th</sup> April - 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018). **Payment must be made in advance;** If you wish to pay weekly, the cost is £10.75 per week, payable in advance on line on School Money.
- If you wish your child to start/stop school lunches please come into the school office and pick up a form. If you wish to stop school lunches, the kitchen will require you to give them **half a term's notice**.

### **SCOOTERS AND BIKES**

Please remember to take home your bike or scooter on Thursday if you have left it in the bike shed as this will be cleared out over Easter.
